



Whilst Phil has always been involved in agriculture, his Valais Blacknose journey began back in 2015 when his wife, Hayley, spotted these 'fluffy sheep' on the Internet and said excitedly, "We've GOT to get some of those!" Away from Valais Blacknose, Phil works in the motor industry and enjoys spending time with Hayley and their four children ranging in age from two to 25 years old.

MARITA TAUNI, DVM

Brought up in an animal-loving family, Marita's goal in life was to become a veterinarian. Marita graduated from vet school in 1988. She bought her first sheep flock in 1991 and started breeding the Swedish heritage breed Rya sheep, which her daughter now proudly continues. There are less than 1000 pedigree Rya sheep left in the world.

Sheep breeding has been her hobby for 30 years. Marita says, "When I fell in love with the Valais Blacknose sheep in Switzerland in 2013, there was no return." Despite hard import restrictions, Marita and her husband Kåre managed to import their flock to Sweden in 2014 from Bavaria. Marita's entire flock was graded in 2019 by Swiss judges and awarded 8 maximum points. "That journey gave us lots of hands-on experience which I am trying to share with other breeders." The passion for the breed takes her to Switzerland every year where she also continued her education to become one of seven graders outside Switzerland, trained and certified by the Swiss Valais Blacknose Sheep Breeding Society, "Oberwalliser Schwarznasen Schafzuchtverband". Marita also speaks German and has assisted The British Valais Blacknose Sheep Society as a translator between speakers and the audience.

The Valais Blacknose sheep have a unique wool which Marita and Kåre try to promote through felting classes at their farm. As a vet, Marita strives to continue to spread knowledge about the breed through fact-seeking and sharing experiences with vets and other breeders.

Marita is also the founder and chairman of the Swedish Valais Blacknose Sheep Society.
